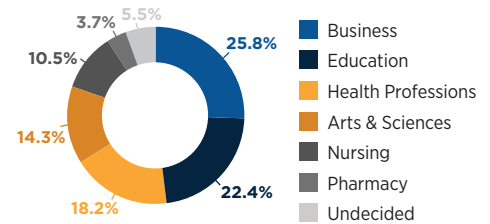

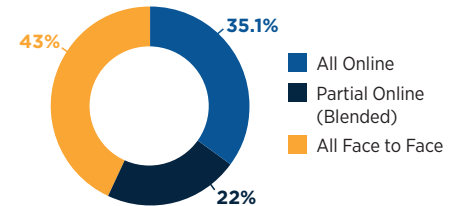

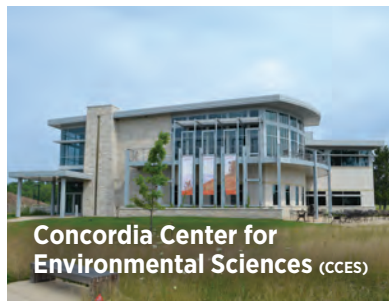

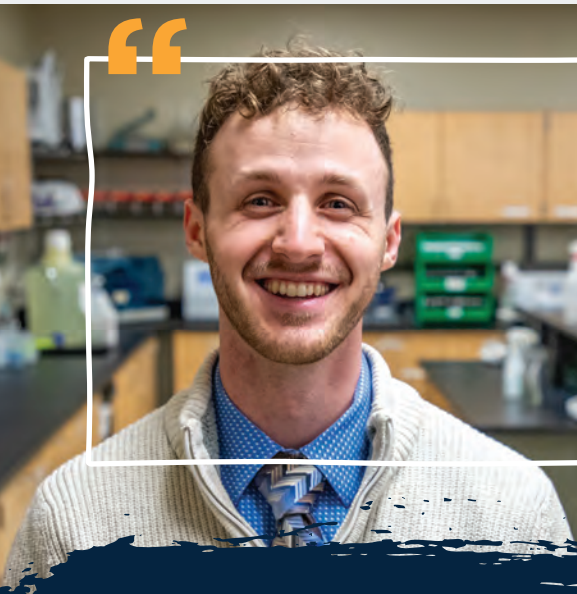
84% of 2022 graduates feel better prepared both to serve and to lead by putting the needs of others first
